The Citizens Utility Board (CUB) will hold a free phone bill clinic for local residents next week.

CUB Executive Director David Kolata and Lt. Governor Pat Quinn stopped by Peoria earlier today to invite residents to the seminar.

Kolata said, "What this is, is free individual analysis of your bill, we see what kind of calls you make, what kind of services you want and then we give you tailored tips on how you can reduce your costs and keep more money for yourself."

Lt. Governor Quinn added, "I think the average savings is about 20-dollars a month, it works to 240 dollars or 250-dollars a year. When you really think about that, that's about two weeks worth of groceries."

The phone clinic is Monday, February 4th at the Peoria Public Library on Monroe Street, from three o'clock until seven in the evening.
