Phone bill clinic offered in Morris

State Sen. Gary Dahl, R-Granville, and the Citizens Utility Board (CUB) are joining forces to help individuals better understand their phone bills and save some money in the process.

"Phone bill clinics" are being held across North Central Illinois to answer consumers' questions and discuss various tips and tricks on how to cut down phone bill expenses. The fairs are being held:

CUB staffers will be on hand to personally go over the bills with consumers. Admission is free of charge.
