Get help cutting your phone bills

ROCKFORD (WREX) - Help is on the way for people struggling to pay their high phone bills.

The Citizens Utility Board's (CUB) "Right Call Campaign" will be in Rockford on Monday, March 30 at 2:00 p.m. helping people cut costs on their bills.

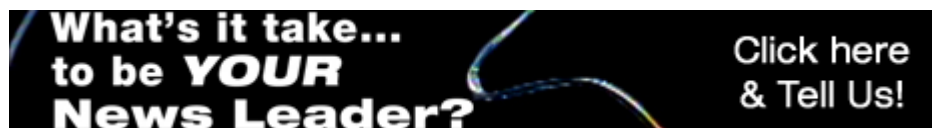
A report from CUB shows people in Illinois are overpaying on their phone bills by \$1.5 billion a year. "Most people are paying too much for phone service," CUB Executive Director David Kolata said. "However, CUB has been showing consumers how to save an average of about \$20 a month on their local and long-distance bills. Plus, we have a new online tool that has been teaching consumers how to slash cell-phone bills by a monthly average of \$25. You just can't get a free service like this anywhere else."

The campaign offers simple tips that could help trim your phone bill by hundreds of dollars a year.

The clinic is being held at the Luther Center, 111 W. State St. #1.

If you go you are asked to bring a copy of your phone bill with you.
