## Residents can learn more about their phone bills

PEORIA — State Rep. Jehan Gordon, D-Peoria, and the Citizens Utility Board will host a phone bill clinic Monday offering residents a free analysis of their phone bill.

The clinic will be from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the McClure Branch Library, 315 W. McClure. Residents will be shown how to reduce their telephone bills and be alerted to scams.
