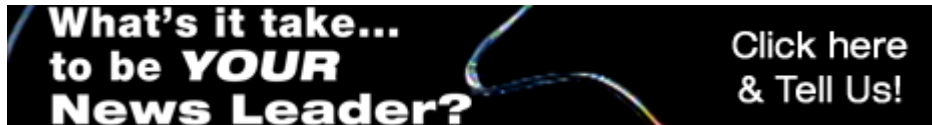
Rockford (WREX)-- A consumer group comes to Rockford to help people dealing with high phone bills.
