## Another clinic to help cut your phone bills scheduled

ROCKFORD (WREX) - The Citizens Utility Board is bringing another clinic to Rockford to help people save money on their phone bills.

CUB's "Right Call Campaign" will be in Rockford again on Wednesday, April 15 at 6:30 p.m. The clinic will be held at Court Street United Methodist Church, 215 N. Court Street.

During their clinic March 30 in Rockford, CUB says it helped save people an average of \$163 a year on their bills.

A report from CUB shows people in Illinois are overpaying on their phone bills by \$1.5 billion a year. "Most people are paying too much for phone service," CUB Executive Director David Kolata said. "However, CUB has been showing consumers how to save an average of about \$20 a month on their local and long-distance bills. Plus, we have a new online tool that has been teaching consumers how to slash cell-phone bills by a monthly average of \$25. You just can't get a free service like this anywhere else."

The campaign offers simple tips that could help trim your phone bill by hundreds of dollars a year.

If you go you are asked to bring a copy of your phone bill with you.
