CUB Offers Ways To Save On Your Cell Bill

CHICAGO (WBBM) -- The Citizens Utility Board is offering cost-saving advice that nearly everyone can use.

CUB Executive Director David Kolata says there's an economic stimulus in almost every cell phone bill and a few simple steps could save you \$331 dollars a year.

Through CUB's online Cellphone Saver which allows you to upload your cell phone bill for free and find a plan that's best for you.

Kolata learned most people are paying for minutes they're not using.

Kolata says you should optimize your plan, avoid phone insurance and stop paying for unnecessary extras like 411 and roadside assistance.

In addition, he advises against a texting plan unless you send out a lot of text messages on a regular basis.

The CUB Cellphone Saver tool was launched last summer, and almost 7-thousand people have used it, so far.
