## CUB Unveils Cost Saving Phone Plans

UNDATED (WIFR) -- The Citizens Utility Board or cub says prices on their cost savings plans are now frozen through 2013. It's part of the new telecommunications act recently passed. CUB has three plans starting as low as \$9.50 a month and covering the basics. Representatives say the biggest problems they see are customers with too many pricey options.

"They're on a plan that gives them way too many calls, they're on a plan that gives them way too many calling features that they never use and they have an overweight bill and what we try to do is put phone bills on a diet." said Jim Chilsen from CUB.

The consumer's choice plans are the result of a legal settlement between cub and AT&T. If you're interested in switching your plan just call AT&T and ask about the consumer's choice plans.
