



## CUB telephone bill clinics focus on rate freeze

PEORIA — The Citizens Utility Board will hold telephone-bill clinics Tuesday in East Peoria and Canton.

CUB wants to alert consumers about a new rate freeze on some low-cost local-calling plans and show ways to cut phone expenses.

A CUB study has estimated Illinois callers could be overpaying by more than \$1 billion a year but most could enjoy big savings by making a few simple changes on their phone bills.

The clinics will be at 10:30 a.m. at the office of the East Peoria Park District, 201 Veterans Drive and at 2 p.m. at the YWCA, 111 N. Ave. A in Canton.
