## Energy Impact Illinois (EI2) - \$99 or Free Residential Energy Audits

Through this program an advisor will help identify how a home uses energy – and wastes it – and identify the most cost-effective improvements someone can make for a more efficient and comfortable home. Elevate Energy provide serves as an advocate for this program, and provides oversight throughout the entire process.

The program also helps homeowners find rebates and loans to reduce the cost of the energy efficiency improvements.

More than 4,000 homes in Illinois have already participated in Energy Impact Illinois, saving an average of \$400 annually on utility bills. Participants also qualify for the Illinois Home Performance with ENERGY STAR (Energy Start certification for you home), if your home becomes 15% more efficient.

The program provides a comprehensive energy assessment of your home for just \$99. Or there is even a free option if you host an energy impact "house party". The free option just requires a homeowner to invite 5-10 friends over to learn about how to make their homes more efficient too.
