## CUB STATEMENT ON ILLINOIS AMERICAN RATE CASE DECISION

CUB is pleased that consumer advocates were able to help reduce Illinois American's proposed rate hike by \$14.2 million. However, we believe the company still got more than it needs or deserves. Consumers' water bills are already too high, and that's why we plan to file a petition for rehearing to challenge the company's \$35 million rate hike, and reduce it further.

## **Background:**

\*On Feb. 24, 2016, Illinois American Water Company filed a request to increase rates by about \$49.5 million with the Illinois Commerce Commission (ICC).

\*In December 2016, the ICC approved an increase of about \$35.3 million, \$14.2 million less than the company requested.

\*Illinois American Water provides service to 314,000 customers from Southern Illinois to the Chicago suburbs.
