


Where's the Price-to-Compare (PTC) on ComEd bills?

What is the PTC?

The price-to-compare (PTC) is the ComEd supply price (7.219 cents per kilowatt-hour) that you compare with alternative supplier offers. It's made up of 2 separate charges on ComEd bills: the "Electricity Supply Charge" (6.472 cents per kWh) + the "Transmission Services Charge" (0.747 cents per kWh)

Where can I find it?

It's in the "Updates" section of all ComEd bills, which is typically on page 2.

What's next?

For years, the price-to-compare was not listed on bills, so this is a step in the right direction. But CUB wants to see the PTC even more prominently displayed.
